This coming Saturday, clergy and parishioners will gather at Lavender Hill Cemetery and Strayfield Road Cemetery for the annual blessing of graves. In normal times this would have taken place last November—the month of the Holy Souls. For obvious 'lockdown' reasons, this could not take place last year, but we are pleased it will do so this coming weekend. We pray for fine weather.

When we gather at the graves of our dear loved ones and pray for their souls, it is not a morbid act founded on despair. Of course, we are sad: that is only natural, and is a sign of our love and

our sense of loss. In the sadness, though, there is real and hopeful expectation.

As we make this solemn pilgrimage to the graves of our loved ones, we are like the women and the disciples who went to the tomb of Jesus 'early on the Sunday morning'. When they arrived they found the situation to be nothing like they had anticipated. The tomb was empty—the Lord had risen. In the light of that glorious mystery we remember and pray for the dead—that they may come to a joyful resurrection in the Lord.
