## Living In Formation

I am very fortunate to be in formation to become a Deacon, God willing, in this parish next year. I have been a member of this parish for 27 years and it is the influence of the amazing people in this parish over this period of time which has helped God to lead me along this path. Deacons are members of the order of the Diaconate, a word derived from the Greek word diakonia meaning service among others, with its roots in scripture. Priests are ordained Deacons as part of their journey towards ordination to the Priesthood. We also have Permanent Deacons who typically stay within or close to their home parish. Many Permanent Deacons are married and I am blessed to be married to Tamara and we have one son age 17. Deacons are called to a threefold ministry of Charity, the Word and the Altar, so are engaged in charitable works giving our time in service to others, proclaiming the Gospel, preaching, and assisting the Priest at the Altar. Deacons can preside at services other than the Mass including baptism, funeral ser-

vices, morning and evening prayer and give benediction. We are expected to be very much in the world of work, so I will be continuing my part time work as a Paramedic and an IT Manager within the NHS. In this way the Church is walking with the people in the family, at schools, workplaces, the street, and reaching out into the wider community. The theme of the readings this Sunday reflect this perfectly. In the psalm the response 'I will walk in the presence of the Lord in the Land of the living', and in the second reading in the letter of St James we hear that our faith is of little use on its own without the acts of good deeds or service that it calls us to. So much good work goes on in our parish reaching out to the local and global community. By doing this we are living out our faith and proving it to others. Life in formation while living a family life and working is demanding, so please pray for me and I will continue to pray for you all.
