## Family Fast Day—Friday 1st October

Many of us will be familiar with fasting, not least in the holy season of Lent. It is a spiritual as well as a physical discipline. When we fast we refrain from certain pleasures and customs with which we are familiar, and seek to focus our hearts and minds on God, and on our brothers and sisters in need.

CAFOD (the Catholic Agency for Overseas development) encourages us to fast this coming Friday 1st October, as a sign of our solidarity with the poor. The money we save through taking less food and drink on that day can be given to the work of CAFOD (the envelopes for our donations will be available this Sunday). Whatever we have to spare will be used constructively and carefully for the good of others. I know that parishioners in Enfield have for a long time been active and generous supporters of CAFOD, and I am sure this will continue to be the case over the next few weeks and into the future. There will be speakers at all Masses this weekend, and volunteers from the Justice & Peace group who will be only too happy to chat with you about the work they do and the various concerns which we are all facing at this time. We continue to pray for the planet—our common home - and for all the people of the world—especially the poor :
