World Mission Sunday - 24th October 2021 - Missio Appeal



Over the years, parishioners in Enfield have provided huge support for Missio and the Mill Hill Missionaries, the Pope's charity for world mission. Hundreds of families regularly put loose change and money into the distinctive "Red Boxes". This means that Enfield has always been one of the most generous parishes when supporting this really worthwhile charity.

If you are unaware of the organisation, Missio ignites God's love by helping local missionaries to work alongside global communities that are poor or in need, regardless of their background or belief. Sometimes this need might be very specific: a motorbike for a Priest to celebrate Mass in remote villages; a simple community hall so people can gather together; vaccinations to protect vulnerable children. Whatever our missionaries need to help them share the joy of the Gospel, Missio strives to provide it.

Obviously, along with other charities, these past 18 months have been a real challenge for Missio, not least because the traditional means of collecting money, through volunteers going round to people's homes to collect the Red Boxes, has not been possible. It is probable that many parishioners have full boxes sitting in their living

room waiting to be collected!

That is why this year, we have decided to ask parishioners with Red Boxes to take home a brown envelope this week at the end of Mass and empty your money from the red boxes into the envelope, and then bring it back to the Church next week on World Mission Sunday. There will also be the opportunity to Gift Aid your donations, or if you think it is easier, to set up a direct debit to give regularly to Missio.

If you are unable to attend Mass next week, please hand the envelope into the Presbytery, or contact Declan Tierney, the new Local Secretary via email: declantierney@gmail.com or phone 07946 568901, and he will arrange collection.

If you do not have a Red Box, and would like one for your family, again contact Declan above, and he can arrange for you to either start up a direct debit payment or provide you with the red box for your home. Alternatively, please feel free to take home a brown envelope, complete your details, and bring it back next week.

Finally, Missio would like to thank Margaret MacAninch, who has retired as the Local Secretary, and her team of volunteers for all their years of hard work helping to collect the Red Boxes in the parish.
