**The Sick & Retired Priests' Collection is next weekend.** The diocese has more than 80 sick and retired priests who receive support after a lifetime of service to their parishes. Most priests offer their resignation as a parish priest at the age of 75, but many continue to serve in our parishes, schools, hospices, and hospitals. At this time, they are dependent on the Diocese for their care (housing, any health needs and other essentials).

These priests have baptised us; welcomed us, and our families, into the Church; counselled us at times of crisis; sat with us through grief and sorrow; and shared in times of joy. They have given to us all and now, in their old age or sickness, they need us to give back.

By giving to the Sick & Retired Priests' Fund, you can ensure our priests are cared for. You can take a donation envelope as you leave Church today, but the envelopes and posters feature a 'QR Code' that you can scan with a phone camera to give online, reducing the risks to everyone of handling cash or touching the envelopes. Please continue to pray for all our clergy: active, retired or ill.
