Every Sunday, clergy, religious and lay faithful around the world pray the *Te Deum* which concludes the Office of Readings. It is both a prayer of praise for God but also an overture of salvation history.

In the middle of the *Te Deum* reads the following: *You, Christ, are the King of glory, Son of the eternal Father.* It is fitting that within this creed of faith, this particular statement should find itself so central, for indeed, Christ is the bridge between earth and heaven; death and life; time and eternity.
