## Credo in unum Deum

The Trinity is Christianity's most basic description of who God actually is and who He needs to be in order to save us. It is at the very heart of what Christians believe, and very little else in Christianity makes sense without it.

Despite this, a great many Christians, including significant numbers of teachers, catechists, and preachers, do not feel confident in approaching the subject.

This is not, I hope, because they do not believe in the Trinity, rather, they are not altogether sure what they think they believe or indeed what they are supposed to, and they fear both revealing their ignorance, and leading others astray.

Having said this, the doctrine of the Trinity is very simple. It consists of three short but deeply scriptural convictions: 1) There is only one God; 2) Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are all God; and 3) Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are not the same.

This of course, can only be confessed by one who has faith. The use of our limited reason

inevitably will fail us in our attempt of trying to understand who God is.

Indeed, the revelation of who God is, ultimately lies with God, as Christ says in St Matthew's gospel:

*"No one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and any one to whom the Son chooses to reveal him."*

We can be sure that Christ has revealed Him to us, because we believe in the One the Father has sent and in the Advocate that we received at our baptism and confirmation, the one and the same Spirit who descended at Pentecost.

What is more, our very identity can be found in the one true God who knew us before we were born and who created us in His image, as Genesis reminds us:

*"Then God said, 'Let us make man in our image, after our likeness'"*
