Saints Peter and Paul

This week we celebrate two great Saints from different backgrounds but we are able to write their names in gold when it comes to the efforts they made to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ.

St Peter was a Galilean fisherman from Bethsaida, who was called by Christ to be a disciple. He was chosen from the disciples and made one of the twelve Apostles by the Lord. He was not just one of the Apostles but was the one who Jesus built his church on, (Matthew 16:18). Because of the Chair he occupied in the Church, he is known as the first Pope of the Catholic Church. Pope Francis is filling in for him today.

Even though Peter denied Jesus three times during his persecution, he cried as a way of showing remorse, and Jesus forgave him and went ahead to make him the head of the Church, "Look after my

sheep" (Jn 21:17). Peter was not an armchair disciple because he went about preaching the new way after Pentecost. For effective mission work he went to Jewish territories as an Apostle to the Jews.

St Paul who was born in Tarsus, Turkey was not one of the Apostles chosen by Jesus Christ himself. He became a believer after his encounter with Christ on his way to Damascus to go and arrest Christians and prosecute them. Prior to that experience he was practising Judaism, a zealous one for that matter. After his conversion and Baptism, the Holy Spirit took hold of him and he equally became an evangelizer to the gentiles.

Both Sts Peter and Paul died as martyrs and are buried in the Vatican City, Rome around 64 AD under Emperor Nero. Their Solemnity is on the 29th of June every year.
