Home at last

You may have heard recently that a film has been made about the well beloved saint, Pius of Pietrelcina, or commonly known as Padre Pio.

The film titled simply 'Padre Pio' was released on 2nd September and features Shia LeBeouf who has starred in many films during his career, including, most notably, *The Transformers Film Franchise*, which arguably made him a household name in Hollywood.

Having said that, his time in the limelight led him quickly down some deep and dark avenues where he is said to have contemplated suicide.

Adding to this, he has a somewhat colourful past being charged with theft, disorderly conduct and harassment to name but a few.

In a recent interview with Bishop Robert Barron (which can be found on YouTube) LeBeouf revealed how playing Padre Pio led to his conversion to Catholicism.

LeBeouf was born to a Jewish mother and Christian father and later discovered he had been baptised by his uncle.

He spent a lot of time with the Capuchins, the same Order that Padre Pio belonged to in preparation for the role. He attended Mass and was particularly drawn to the Traditional Latin Mass. He commented that he could almost feel the physical effect and regeneration of entering into Christ's death and resurrection after receiving Holy Communion.

LeBeouf was encouraged by the conversion of St Augustine and the life of St Francis of Assisi which helped him on his journey home to faith. This is truly good news that often does not see the light of day, so let us give thanks to God for his conversion and keep him in our prayers.
