Parishioners will remember John Casey fondly. He has written to us to let us know how his formation for priesthood is progressing. Please continue to remember him in your prayers.

Greetings from Our Lady of Fatima in White City near Shepherds Bush. I arrived here on the 10th of September, and as a keen gardener, I was pleased to find that the church is surrounded by beautiful gardens which are enjoyed by parishioners and local people. People sit on the benches having chats at all hours of the day.

Many families in the area struggle to feed their children, but I have been touched by the generosity of many who give time and support to various projects (including 'Food Cycle' serving food on Saturdays and a food-bank on Mondays).

The parish hall accommodates many other activities including catechist activities, social groups, with activities for older members of

the community. These initiatives are not just for parishioners. The Church truly does serve the community.

I am very blessed to visit families and bring communion to the sick. This is a real graced privilege. Bringing Christ to them reminds me of the Gospel message to go out and proclaim the Good News. It can be easy for us to forget those who cannot attend services due to any type of illness. Livestream masses helps, but it is beautiful to witness how much the real presence of Christ in the eucharist means to people. Perhaps this is a time to respond to your vocational calling to offer to be ministers that can take communion to the sick. You will never regret it.
