Fr Daniel writes .....on the Sacred and the Secular

In this week's editorial I will deal with two different, but equally important aspects of the Catholic Faith. Namely, the way we live out our faith in the world, and also the manner in which we behave when we are in church. We know that actions speak louder than words.

Firstly, we continue to consider the questions we might well pose to the candidates standing in the General Election, particularly in the light of what we believe as Catholics. Here are two more, linked to the climate crisis:

- 1) We know that we need to move away from fossil fuels if we are to have any chance of halting the climate crisis. Would you work to ensure that the UK finally ends all new oil, coal and gas projects and phases out existing ones?
- 2) Some of the world's poorest communities are facing the greatest burden of the climate crisis. With millions of people already displaced as a result of extreme weather events, how would you support working with other coun-

tries to raise new taxes from the most polluting industries such as shipping, aviation and fossil fuels to support countries suffering the impacts of climate change?

Secondly, lest we forget the need to constantly be refreshed and renewed in our devotional life, here are two pointers I came across recently:

- 1) Face the tabernacle when making the Sign of the Cross. This is the declaration that you are living in the Trinitarian life inaugurated on earth by Our Lord himself. So, when we make the Sign of Cross as we enter church or at the beginning of Mass look at the tabernacle where Christ himself is present.
- 2) Genuflect (or bow deeply) imagining a king. When we genuflect/bow to the tabernacle we should imagine that we are before the throne of Christ the King, who wears a crown. This is in fact, what we are doing. It is an act of worship in itself.
