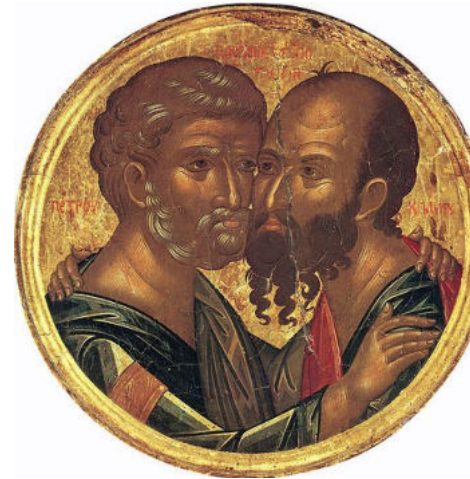

The Petrine and Pauline Church



I have an image of this 15th century icon, made in Crete, in my bedroom upstairs. It is a beautiful image of Saints Peter and Paul embracing. We celebrate their feast day today.

Since the third century the Church has celebrated their feast together. It may seem odd at first that these two giants of our Christian faith don't have their own feast day. But there is a very good reason for it.

Saint Peter (on the left of our icon, always depicted in art with a shorter grey beard),

was entrusted by Jesus himself to be the leader of the Church. In our Gospel reading today Jesus says to Peter 'feed my lambs, feed my sheep'. Peter thus is the organiser, the leader and represents office, order and direction. This is the PETRINE element of our Church.

If we only had that, then the Church would become hard, stale, unmoving, petrified (literally!). This is where the PAULINE element comes in. Saint Paul (depicted on the right, always featuring a long, brown beard in art) was the adventurer, the man with the missionary zeal, reaching out, conversing, spreading the Word, actively going forth. But without the Petrine element, the Pauline element would run amok, leading to a fragmented, scattered church where each community would do their own thing.

That is why this image of Peter and Paul embracing is the perfect model for the Church, having both elements of the church always closely working together: upholding tradition and order, yet always creative and missionary.
