Don't shoot the messenger!

How good are we at receiving criticism or feedback? I work shifts in a call centre and our work is reviewed by a team of auditors who are not always popular. The same applies at home, school, college, university and in the workplace, we will receive criticism and feedback. We should always listen and reflect on it honestly, and it will help us to become the best version of ourselves that we can be.

The first reading this Sunday is from Ezekiel: The Lord sent Ezekiel to the rebels among the Israelites, to tell them: 'Whether they listen or not, this set of rebels shall know there is a prophet among them'. Were the rebels happy to have the prophet among them? Did they recognise who he was or listen to what he had

to say? Ezekiel was slain, like Isaiah, Amos, Micah, Habakkuk and Jeremiah. In the Gospel we heard what the people were saying about Jesus: 'This is the carpenter, surely, the son of Mary'. They would not accept Him, and Jesus said to them: 'A prophet is only despised in his own country, among his own relations and in his own house'. He was amazed at their lack of faith because they didn't recognise that He was the Son of God.

Do we recognise Jesus when He is walking among us, or when He is telling us something we don't want to hear?
