Pilgrims of Hope

In this Sunday's Gospel reading we hear Jesus sending the Twelve out in pairs. They are to begin the mission, preaching repentance, casting out devils and anointing sick people with oil so that they might be cured.

One way of understanding this sending out of the disciples is that of a pilgrimage. The concept of pilgrimage is central to the life of faith. Each one of us who has been baptised will hopefully realise that at our baptisms we began a journey of faith, a pilgrimage with the Lord, and within His Church.

Next year—2025—is a Holy or Jubilee Year. These years (usually each 25 years, although there are also additional ones such as the

Year of Mercy in 2016) mark significant anniversaries since the birth of Our Lord. They are times of celebration, repentance and an opportunity to recommit ourselves to the mission we have each received.

Pope Francis has given the Jubilee Year the title 'Pilgrims of Hope'. This evocative phrase reminds us that as well as being pilgrims, we are a people of hope. The hope we possess is founded in Christ and His resurrection. As Pope Francis has written, it is *'the virtue that gives inward direction and purpose to the life of believers.'*

We look forward to the Holy Year, conscious of the hope that is in us. Fr Daniel
