## Remembrance Sunday

---

The month of November is the Month of the Holy Souls, and this Sunday we commemorate the sacrifice made by those brave men and women during war time, WWI, and WWII.

**Perpetual light shine upon them Lord, may they rest in peace. Amen.**

Let us remember them and pray for them, that they be in a place of refreshment, light and peace.

As we continue on in this month, we will notice the liturgical mood will begin to change. The world tells us to start preparing for Christmas, but the Church is inviting us to prepare for the end of Ordinary Time and to receive Christ as a humble King, who will come and put an end to all conflict. In fact, all conflict stops at the foot of the Cross. We remember this every time we come to Mass, because every Sunday we are invited to the Passover, from Death to Life with Christ himself, in that sacrifice He did once and for all for us.

Jesus, like the letter to the Hebrews says, is The High Priest, who identifies with us in everything but sin, so that we may be able to receive all the graces necessary to live a good
