continues from last week (6:17,20-26) with 'The Sermon on the Plain'. Matthew also recounts similar teachings in 'The Sermon on the Mount' (Mathew 5:3-12).

We all live by rules and laws which are important, and without them the world would be even more chaotic and unjust. The religious at the time were good at making laws for everything, and Jesus saw the problem: For every rule someone will find a way around it without breaking it! That is without breaking the letter of the law, but usually breaking the spirit of it.
